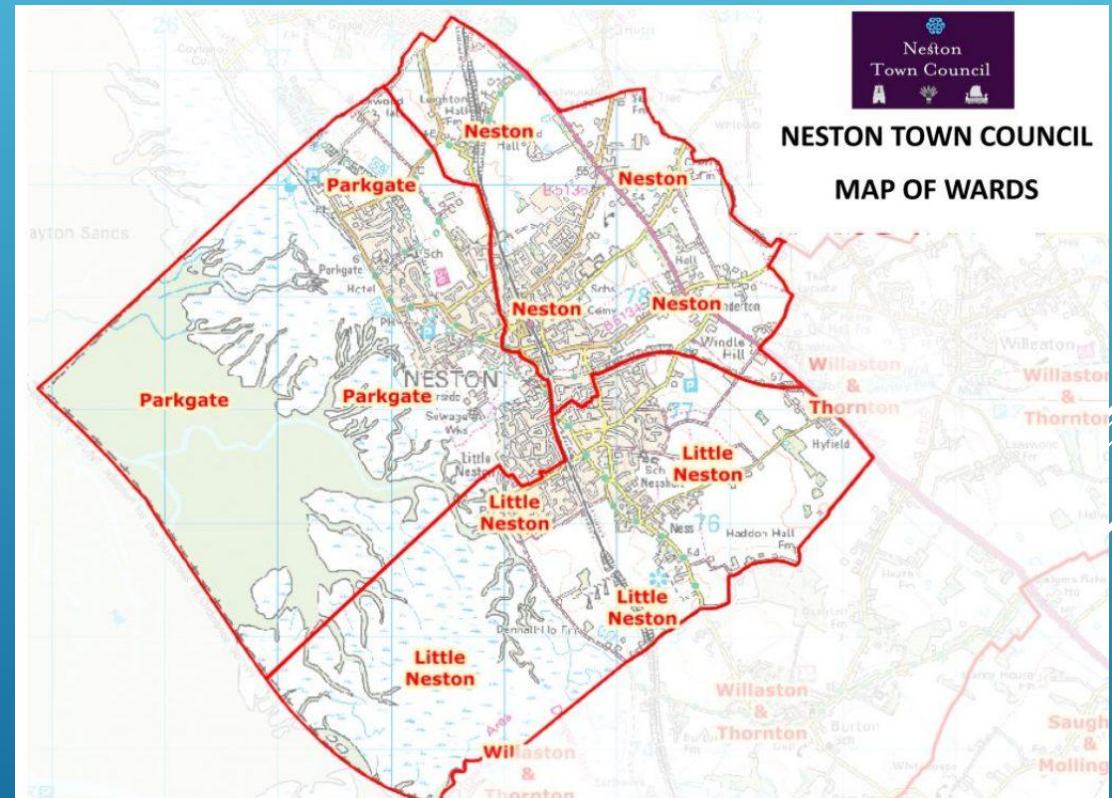

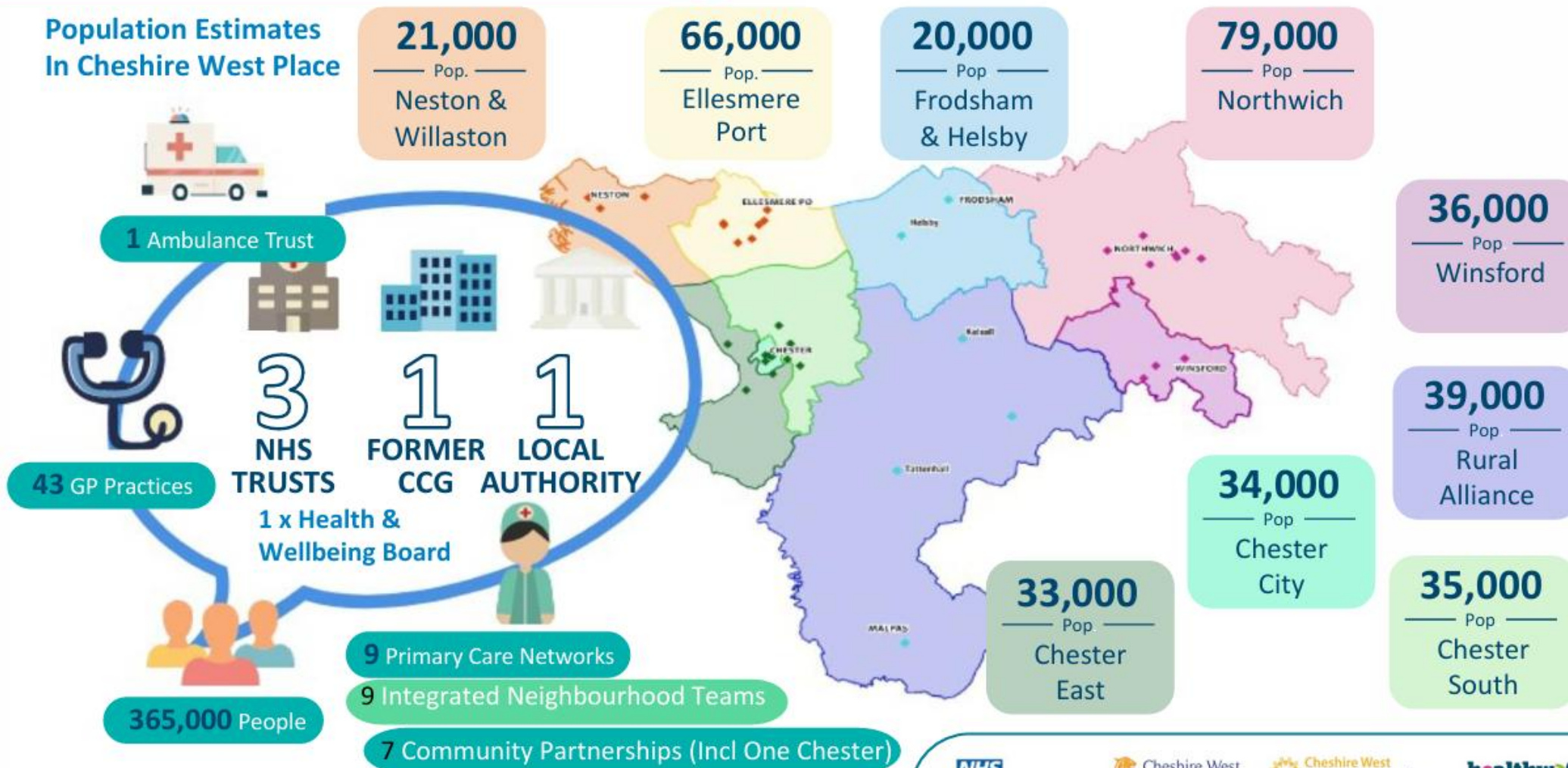

WARD PROFILE SUMMARY

- ▶ Total Population – 20,646
- ▶ Percentage of population aged over 65 – 30.3% compared to 21.5% (CW&C) and 18.8% (England and Wales)
- ▶ Percentage of population aged 0-15 – 14.5% compared to 17.3% (CW&C) and 18.5% (England and Wales)
- ▶ Percentage of residents (over 18) who said their health was 'bad' or 'very bad' – 4.9% compared to 5.2% (CW&C) and 5.2% (England and Wales)
- ▶ Percentage of reception children classed as overweight (including obesity) – 25.5% compared to 19.9% (CW&C) and 22.1% (England and Wales)
- ▶ Percentage of year 6 children classed as overweight (including obesity) – 25.1% compared to 34.4% (CW&C) and 36.6% (England and Wales)
- ▶ Percentage of children eligible for free school meals – 13.9% compared to 19.1% (CW&C). Worth noting that Neston ward is 28.6%
- ▶ Percentage of 1 person (aged 66+) households – 16.9% compared to 13.7% (CW&C) and 12.9% (England and Wales)
- ▶ Anti-social behaviour rate – 6.2 compared to 11.3 (CW&C). Worth noting Neston ward is 12.3

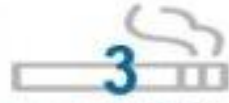

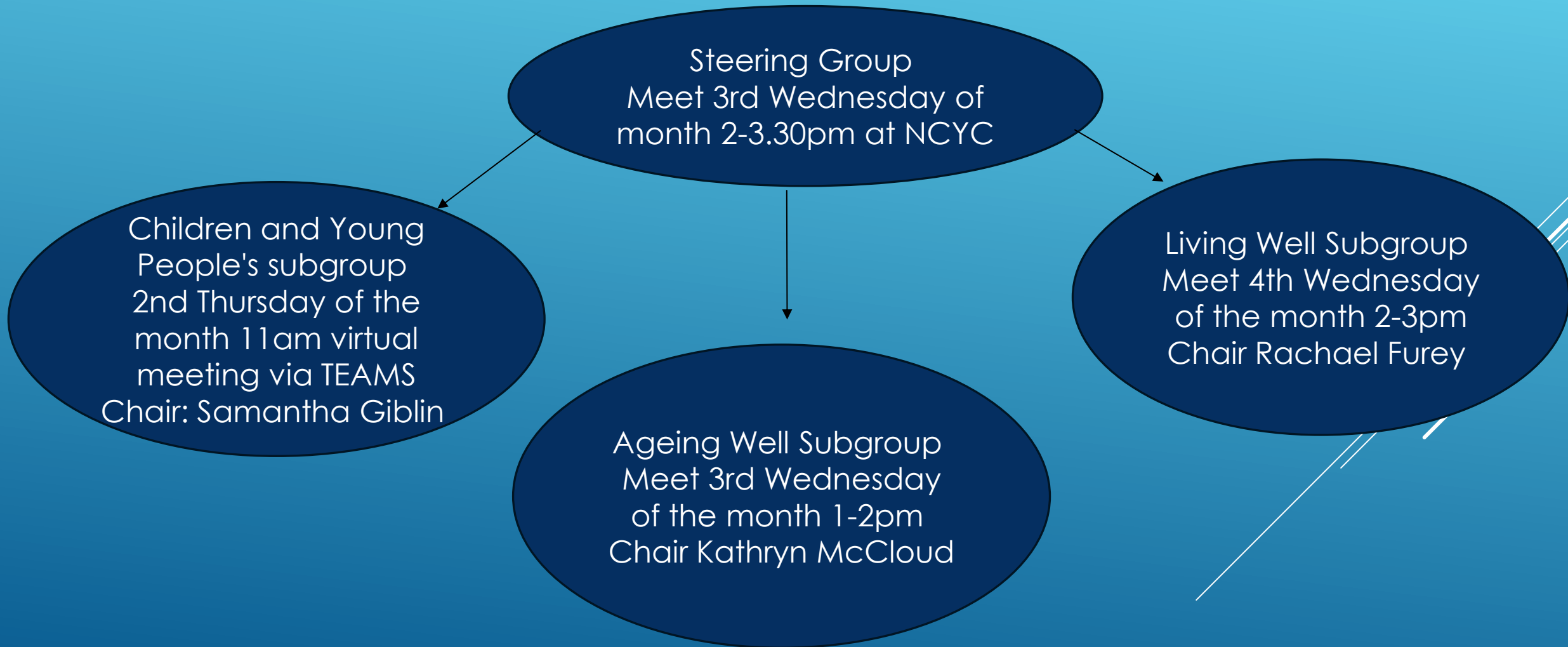

Ageing Well Subgroup

Focus-

- Volunteer Recruitment
- Raising awareness of Local services available for the older population and support for those experiencing falls and falls prevention.

Children and Young People Subgroup

Focus-

- Increase Youth Provision in the Local area
- Encourage Young People to have a say in what activities and support are important to them.

Living Well Subgroup

Focus-

- To help the population be more active
- Consolidate and centralize information on local walks to make it easily accessible for people to find.

Improvement in provision for children and young people

- Continue to grow the Young Voices of Neston Project, ensuring the voice of local young people is heard and acted upon.

Increasing provision of social opportunities

- Full Circle Intergenerational Group
- Support and promotion of existing activities in the local area

Ageing Well

- Falls support- proposal for a falls cushion scheme to be implemented in the local area.
- Falls prevention information to be easily accessible.

Living Well for all

- Initial proposals in progress to collate and centralize local walks, maps and guides to be easily accessed by all ages and abilities.

Some of our Achievements so far in 2026...

Children and Young People Sub Group:

Young Voices of Neston group gathered over 20 responses from Children and young people about what activities they would like to see in the local area

Outcome- organised free photography workshop sessions over the summer holidays for age 9-18.

Ageing Well Sub group:

Creation of an Ageing Well sub group flyer to promote local services and volunteering opportunities.

Neston Market stall in June '26 with attendees from Dementia Together, Retain Wellbeing CIC, CWAC and NCYC.

Living Well Sub group:

Newly formed group in June '26
New members on board to help shape the group and it's aims.
